V-Ferret Tests

V-Ferret comes with tests to find:

Accounts Payable

- Un-posted transactions and checks
- Transactions dated and posted in different periods
- Batch types hitting the wrong account
- Credit memos not applied to an invoice

Accounts Receivable

- Un-posted transactions
- Zero balance batches
- Transactions dated and posted in different periods
- Incorrect batch types
- Dates not in predefined periods
- Discrepancies between cash receipts and receivables
- Transactions with totals that do not match the sum of its lines or postings to the control account
- Invoices with paid amounts not equal to the sum of applied payments
- Detail lines incorrectly using control accounts

Cash Book

- Zero balance batches
- Transactions dated and posted in different periods

General Ledger

- Discrepancies between account balance detail and summary amounts
- Chart of account indenture errors

Inventory

- Un-posted distributions
- Transaction dates out of range
- Discrepancies between inventory balance and inventory valuation
- Residual inventory balances
- Part descriptions containing undesirable characters such as " '

Receiving

- Zero balance batches
- Transactions dated and posted in different periods

Shipping

- Un-invoiced shipments
- Transactions dated and posted in different periods

- Un-posted and incomplete transactions
- Transaction dates out of range
